Now that the 2011 elections have concluded, I am thrilled to report to our shareholders that the state of the Republican Party of Pennsylvania is strong as we continue to deliver key Republican victories throughout our Commonwealth.


Dear Friends,



U.S. SENATE: DEFEATING BOB CASEY

HARNESSING THE SOCIAL MEDIA REVOLUTION

Social media has completely revolutionized the way voters communicate about politics online and over Chairman Gleason's term we have taken major strides to utilize cutting edge social media technology. This does not just mean having a Facebook page, Twitter account and YouTube channel; it's about redefining and optimizing how we use these tools to fine-tune our ability to target voters with our messages and spur them to action.

By constantly serving fresh, interesting and relevant content in each of our social media outlets, the amount of interactions we have been able to earn has exploded. In 2011, we quadrupled the number of Facebook fans who like the PA GOP's Facebook page. We had over 100,000 views on our YouTube channel and nearly doubled our number of Twitter followers. We will continue building on these successes in 2012 by providing new content and translating this online interaction into potential volunteers, donors and voters.

REVAMPING TRADITIONAL EARNED MEDIA

Infusing our message in the media - television, radio, print and online outlets - is absolutely critical to our effort to provide mass audiences with the opportunity to engage with our Party's principles and candidates.

In 2011, we continued to develop our earned media capabilities by developing relationships with various media outlets to encourage them to include our content in their reporting. This bolstered our efforts to assist our 2011 judicial candidates with securing interviews, as well as booking Republican surrogates across the state to provide conservative commentary on key issues of the news cycle. We also launched the "Power Play," a weekly e-mail containing top GOP talking points to circulate among key reporters, surrogates and party stakeholders.

Our efforts to acquire earned media in 2012 will expand exponentially as we work with Republican candidates up and down the ballot - from the Republican nominee for President to State Senate and House members - to ensure that our winning message is on the air every news cycle!

DRIVING NATIONAL MESSAGES IN PENNSYLVANIA

The Presidential election will have a profound impact on political communications throughout the 2012 cycle. Because of heightened national interest, more voters will be paying attention to this election and it will be important for us to make national messaging relevant to everyday Pennsylvanians so that we can better convey why our Party and our candidates best represent our Pennsylvania values.

KEEPING DEMOCRATS ACCOUNTABLE

One way that we can utilize national messages is by executing an aggressive bracketing program to keep Democrats accountable to the Pennsylvania constituents they serve. For example, whenever President Obama or one of his surrogates travels to Pennsylvania, we will be ready to have our own documents and talking points ready to issue to encourage media outlets to include our point of view in their reports. Pennsylvanians deserve to know where the candidates stand on important issues and we will make sure that Democrats are held accountable as they travel our Commonwealth.

COLLABORATING WITH THE RNC, NRSC, NRCC

We have built strong partnerships with the three national committees - Republican National Committee (RNC), National Republican Senatorial Committee (NRSC) and National Republican Congressional Committee (NRCC) - to better execute our shared vision of electing Republicans to serve in Washington, D.C. The RNC, NRSC and NRCC have been invaluable in providing support for each of our political and communications strategies and we look forward to building on our successful partnerships to continue to deliver key victories that impact the national political scene.

BUILDING A STATEWIDE VICTORY

one precinct, one county at a time

REPUBLICANS EARNED HISTORIC VICTORIES IN 2011.

From electing Anne Covey to Pennsylvania's Commonwealth Court, to expanding our majority at the county level by electing a net of 12 new county courthouse majorities, Republicans dominated the 2011 cycle. These victories place us in an ideal position to defeat President Obama and Senator Casey and elect Republicans up and down the ballot this year.



COMMONWEALTH COURT JUDGE ANNE COVEY

Despite facing a significant statewide voter registration disadvantage of more than 1.2 million voters, we were able to build upon our historic victories in 2010 and deliver another statewide victory.

Republican Anne Covey soundly defeated extreme liberal Democrat Kathryn Boockvar in her 2011 bid for Commonwealth Court, winning with 52.4% of the vote.

Our campaign operation helped put Covey over the top in an odd-year election where turnout hovered around 23% statewide.

EXPANDING OUR MAJORITY LOCALLY

In 2011, we had a great deal of success at the local level, where Republicans netted 12 courthouses out of Democrat control, expanding the majority of Republican-controlled courthouses to 75%, from 40 in 2007 to 52 today.

Nine of these wins occurred in "blue" counties where Democrats have a voter registration advantage - Cambria, Carbon, Centre, Clinton, Elk, Lawrence, Mercer, Monroe and Westmoreland. Only five of the counties we picked up - Bradford, Forest, Northumberland, Schuylkill and Susquehanna - have a Republican voter registration advantage. In all of these counties we witnessed Republicans, Independents and even Democrats rejecting President Obama's Democrat Party and their big government agenda, proving that great Republican candidates can compete and win even in the most Democratic counties in the Commonwealth.

Barack Obama's failed policies have left us with \$15 trillion in debt, a nearly 9% unemployment rate, and a feeling that the American dream is no longer attainable. We need new leadership in America and we need it now. The stakes are too high to sit on the sidelines.

A Presidential candidate must win a majority of the total number of electoral votes in order to be successful on Election Day. 270 is the magic number, and the GOP has a clear path to victory.

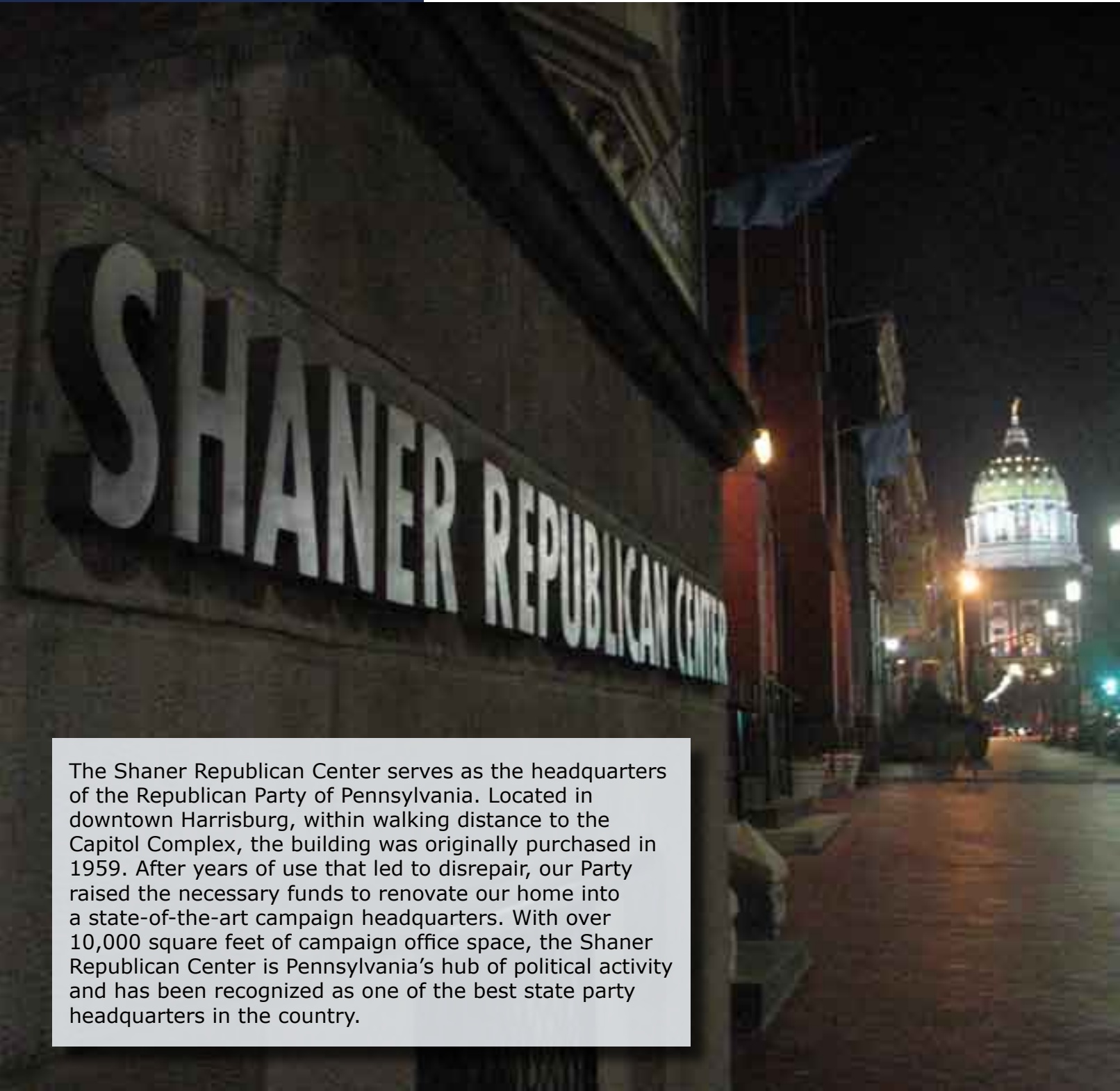

The Shaner Republican Center serves as the headquarters of the Republican Party of Pennsylvania. Located in downtown Harrisburg, within walking distance to the Capitol Complex, the building was originally purchased in 1959. After years of use that led to disrepair, our Party raised the necessary funds to renovate our home into a state-of-the-art campaign headquarters. With over 10,000 square feet of campaign office space, the Shaner Republican Center is Pennsylvania's hub of political activity and has been recognized as one of the best state party headquarters in the country.

ANNUAL BUILDING FUNDRAISER

In 2011, we launched our annual Building Fundraiser at the Shaner Republican Center to continue to raise critical funds necessary to support our Party's operations at our headquarters to defray the costs of our mortgage.

Nearly 50 attendees mingled with special guests Governor Tom Corbett, Lieutenant Governor Jim Cawley, PA Senate President Pro Tempore Joe Scarnati and PA House Speaker Sam Smith, and we raised nearly \$300,000 towards paying off the mortgage of the building.
